Administrative/Biographical History:

Wanda Mildred Gelles Griffin (1922-2015) was born, and spent her whole life, in Anchorage, Alaska. After graduating from Anchorage High School in 1940 and working at Providence Hospital on 9th and L Street, she married Ned Griffin on May 9, 1942. Together, they raised 4 children (Chuck, Marie, Tim, and Mark) in Wanda's childhood home at 6th and L Street. In 1950, the couple opened the Knik Arms Apartments on Northern Lights and Spenard Road, which Wanda managed and Ned maintained until they sold the building in 1968.

Wanda was the longest-term parishioner of Holy Family Cathedral and was heavily involved in the church, including serving as chair to the Altar Society. Wanda was also a longtime member of the Cook Inlet Historical Society and was involved with the Anchorage Museum, helping to identify photographs of early Anchorage.¹
